### Registration requirements

- If English is not your first language, an English fluency test is required to confirm your proficiency in English. Applicants may choose from the tests below.
- Results from combining tests are not accepted.
- Test scores must be submitted within six months of the test date.
- If your test results expire at any time during the application process or prior to registration, you may be required to provide updated English test results.
